# CUSTOM FIT AND FABULOUS: CREATE A SIMPLE UNSTRUCTURED JACKET PATTERN, CUSTOM FIT TO YOU



No more one-size-fits-all, or clothes from rectangles! Using a time-tested classic jacket pattern, students will learn to custom fit for their individual figures. Some simple flat pattern and drafting skills will be taught in this workshop. Expect to leave with a finished pattern and directions to make a fabulous yet easy jacket from your hand-woven fabric.

### SUPPLY LISTS:

a. Each student including myself will need a table and chair (two students could share a large cafeteria type table). A full-length mirror and garment rack for hanging samples will be needed. The room should be large enough for students to comfortably move around. Also, please provide an electric or battery operated pencil sharpener.

b. Students should bring:

- TAPE MEASURE
- SCISSORS
- 2 OR 3 GOOD QUALITY COLORED PENCILS (i.e. Sanford Prismacolor)
- NOTEBOOK AND PEN (a highlighter is also helpful)
- PUSH PINS
- A CARDBOARD CUTTING BOARD WITH PRINTED GRID IF POSSIBLE (IT REALLY HELPS)
- SEE-THRU STRAIGHT EDGE RULER
- FRENCH CURVE (OPTIONAL)

c. I will be bringing many different examples of the basic jacket. Some are used for sample sizes for students to use for comparison. I will bring the pattern paper necessary for students to copy their individual patterns. In addition, I provide an extensive handout with detailed illustrations for constructing the jacket.
